

Lab sheet 9.5 : Multiple Forms

Instructions:

Requirement:

1. Click the “Determine Total Income” button to display a 2nd form.
2. Click the “Compute Total Income” button to sum up the values in the 2nd form and display the result back to the text box of the 1st form.

Interface:
